NOTICE REGARDING RECRUITMENT OF TUTOR/CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR (NURSING) ON DIRECT RECRUITMENT BASIS IN AIIMS, NAGPUR.

Reference is invited to the advertisement No: AIIMS/NGP/Rect/Tutor/2021/01 Dated: 08.01.2022 for recruitment of Tutor/Clinical Instructor (Nursing) on direct recruitment basis in AIIMS Nagpur, the Computer Based Test (CBT) is tentatively scheduled to be held on 08th April, 2022. The details regarding the examination are:

- a. The syllabus of the examination is only indicative: The questions can assess any aspect of knowledge, aptitude, attitude and practical skills, which is expected from a trained person to work efficiently at the level of advertised posts of Tutor/ Clinical Instructor (Nursing).
 - b. The examination will be computer-based test (CBT) with 100 Multiple choice questions (MCQ). Each MCQ will have 4 options. For each correct answer 1 mark will be awarded for each of 100 MCQs (100 Marks) and there will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.
 - c. The duration of examination will be 2 hours.
 - d. The PwBD candidates may choose to bring their own scribe as per the rules prescribed by Government of India. However, they will need a prior permission. They will be given only 40 minutes extra time (20 minutes/hour) for the examination.
 - e. The final result of the examination will be used only for shortlisting of candidates for the personal interview, the date of which will be notified later. The marks obtained in the written examination will be used only for shortlisting and will not be carried forward in the personal interview.
2. A list of shortlisted candidates for each post in the ratio of 1:3 *for each advertised category in each post will be notified.* In case of tie, all the candidates with equal marks will be invited for final document verification and personal interview. The result of the shortlisted candidates will be displayed in order of their roll number.
 3. All the eligible shortlisted candidate will be invited for the final document verification and personal interview.
 4. At any stage of recruitment if it is found that any candidate does not fulfill the eligibility criteria as mentioned in the advertisement, his/her candidature will

be cancelled immediately, irrespective of his/her merit in the shortlisting examination.

5. The details of shortlisting examination are as following:

- i. The CBT Examination will be conducted in Bengaluru, Nagpur and New Delhi City only.
- ii. Accordingly the schedule of the examinations and other important dates are as under:

Downloading of Admit Card	Will be notified later
The duration of the examination shall be 2 hours (120 minutes). For scribe candidates 20 minutes extra per hour.	
Scheme of Examination	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. 100 MCQs of 100 marks (Total) with four alternatives for each question. 1 mark will be awarded for each correct answer.2. There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.3. The examination is only for shortlisting the candidates for the personal interview. The details of shortlisting procedure are being notified separately. The dates for the personal interview will be notified later after the examination.
Syllabus of Examination	The questions can assess any aspect of knowledge, aptitude, attitude and practical skills, which is expected from a trained person to work efficiently at the level of advertised post of Tutor/Clinical Instructor (Nursing).

Note: Candidates who have filled **MULTIPLE APPLICATION forms for one post** with same or little different details will be allowed to sit only once against only one of the application form which was filled most recent. Previous filled duplicate forms can be cancelled without any information.

6. Candidates are advised to assure that they should download admit card and appear for the examination only using their latest application. Any candidate found with multiple admit cards for one post or using any unfair practice will be disqualified from the examination before the admission to venue or even at any stage of examination. Appropriate legal action can be taken against them by the competent authority.

7. All candidates are advised to download their admit cards from website <http://aiimsnagpur.edu.in>. Only website generated Admit Cards will be treated as authentic and permissible to appear in the said Examination. **No admit cards will be sent by post.** All applicants are required to visit the AIIMS Nagpur website <http://aiimsnagpur.edu.in> regularly as all subsequent corrigendum / Addendum / Updates will only be uploaded on the above-mentioned website only.
