Young Researcher Award

- Ranks 1–5 (Offline): Awarded in Life, Health, and Pharmaceutical Sciences categories for both oral and poster presentations.
- Cash Prize: ₹30 Lakh (shared among top rankers)
- Age Limit: Up to 35 years (as of 22 November 2026)

Best Presentation Award

- Ranks 6–10 (Offline): For oral and poster presentations in Life, Health, and Pharmaceutical Sciences.
- Ranks 1–5 (Virtual): For oral presentations only in Life, Health, and Pharmaceutical Sciences.
- Age Limit: Up to 45 years (as of 22 November 2026)
- Cash Prize: None

Young Scientist Award

- Ranks 1–5: For presenters aged above 35 years and below 45 years (as of 22 November 2026).
- Cash Prize: None

NBRCOM Pride Award

- One awardee from each organizing institute: Selected from the organizing committee members in recognition of their outstanding contributions.

Indo Nova Science Award

- The Scientific Committee will nominate three outstanding scientists/academicians in Life, Health, and Pharmaceutical Sciences for this prestigious award.

Eligible Criteria

- The NBRCOM-2026 is open to all biomedical researchers (UG, PG, PhD, resident doctors, JRF, SRF, postdocs, clinicians, scientists, and faculties).
- To be eligible for the Young Research Award, age of the presenters/researchers should be less than 35 years as on 22-11-2026.
- However, researchers over the age of 35 years can present their research at NBRCOM-2026 for Young Scientist Award/Best Presentation Award.
- Researchers/Students who are working under the members (faculty/scientists/doctors etc) of the organizing committee are not eligible for any prizes and awards. However, they are allowed to participate and present their research work at NBRCOM 2026.
- Researchers/Students who are working under the jury members are not eligible for prizes and awards in the same category where the jury member is judging. However, if their presentation is in a different category, then they will be eligible for prizes and awards.
- In case of Jury members, if there is any type of 'conflict of interest' with respect to judging the presentation, they will inform the organizing committee before proceeding to judge the presentations.
- Young researcher awardees (1st, 2nd & 3rd prize winners) in NBRCOM-2018, -2019, -2021, and (1st to 5th prize winners) in NBRCOM-2023, -2024 & -2025 can present their research work at NBRCOM 2026, but they will not be eligible for prizes and Young Researcher Award in the NBRCOM-26. But they are eligible for Young Scientist Award and Best Presentation Award.
- The event will be held in a hybrid mode, offering both virtual and offline options.
- The virtual mode is available primarily for researchers working outside of India, although a few presentations from researchers at Indian universities or institutes may be considered based on genuine reasons.

Evaluation Criteria

- The NBRCOM 2026 will be conducted from 18–22 November 2026.
- 18-19 November 2026: Virtual Research Presentation Competition
- 20- 21 November 2026: Offline Research Presentation Competition at AIIMS Nagpur
- 22 November 2026: Scientific Conclave and Award Ceremony.
- Each presenter will deliver their research work within 7 minutes, followed by 2 minutes for addressing questions and/or concerns from the jury and the audience.
- The evaluation criteria for prizes and awards are as follows:
- 75% marks will be based on novelty, knowledge, and presentation (awarded by jury members).
- 25% marks will be based on plagiarism check and review report.
- Reviews and case reports will not be considered for competition at NBRCOM 2026. The names of the winners along with their ranks in each category will be announced during the award ceremony of the conclave on 22 November 2026. The decision of the judges will be final and binding, and no further clarification will be entertained. If any researcher or participant notices a discrepancy or feels that any faculty, jury member, or organizing committee member has shown undue favoritism, the matter may be reported directly to SYBS India at sybsindia18@gmail.com.
- All registered presenters and participating delegates will receive both Presentation and Participation Certificate.

Abstract Submission Guidelines

- The abstract should be written in English and adhere to the structured format (Title, Background, Material Methods, Results, Conclusion and Key words).
- Font Size- 12; Font Style- Times New Roman

Multiple Abstract Submissions and Presentation Policy:

- Researchers who wish to present more than one research work, either in the same or different categories, must:
- Submit separate abstracts for each research work
- Complete separate registrations using different email addresses
- Registration fees will be applicable for each individual submission/registration.
- The same abstract cannot be submitted or presented in more than one category.
- Each abstract must be unique and submitted under a single appropriate category only.
