I. Hospital Services :-

II. Workshops, Training & Events :

- Training on **IA & QMS for Medical Laboratories** as per ISO 15189:2022 and NABL 112A & 112B guidelines were organized by the **Department of Biochemistry** from **1st to 4th July, 2026**.



- The **Department of Anesthesiology & Department of Nursing** organized a "**Training of Trainers (ToT)**" session for Senior Nursing Officers as part of **Annual BLS Training Programme 2026** from **7th July to 10th July 2026**.



- A **Faculty Development Program** was held on **10th July, 2026** wherein the **Departments of General Medicine and Cardiovascular & Thoracic Surgery** had presented case studies.

- **College of Nursing** in collaboration with the Association of Nurse Executives India conducted a **CNE** on “**Leading Safe care Essentials for Nurse Managers**” with the grant in aid of **MoHFW** from **11th to 18th July 2026**. The programme was conceptualized with an aim to enable participants to build expertise in preventing, identifying and managing patient safety incidents and contribute to improved care quality in their healthcare facilities.
- The **Department of Burns and Plastic Surgery**, AIIMS Nagpur, organised a **Continuing Medical Education (CME)** program on **12th July 2026** on “**Advances in the Management of Diabetic Foot**”, with participation from eminent faculty across the country. The CME was organized with an aim to provide an academic platform for clinicians, surgeons, residents and healthcare professionals to update their knowledge and skills regarding the latest advances, multidisciplinary approaches and operative management techniques in diabetic foot care.
- The **Department of General Medicine** organized a Guest lecture with Hands-on Training Session on “**AI in Healthcare**” on **23rd July 2026**. The training programme included session on the application of Artificial Intelligence in Medical education, Research and clinical practice.

III. New facilities/ Milestone achievements:

- **A truly proud milestone for AIIMS, Nagpur. :** The **Department of Orthopedics** successfully completed 1000 joint replacement surgeries over the last four years including robotic assisted joint replacement surgeries with over 80% of the surgeries performed were free of cost.
- **Vidarbha’s 1st Comprehensive Integrated Electrophysiology (VEP, EOG & ERG) System** was inaugurated in the **Department of Ophthalmology** on **10th July 2026**. This state-of-the-art facility will enable early and accurate diagnosis of retinal diseases.



- The **Department of Forensic Medicine & Toxicology** on **21st July 2026** established the **“Poison Information Centre (PIC)”**, an evidence-based toxicovigilance initiative supported by the UK based TOXBASE clinical toxicology database.



- The **“Urodynamic Lab”** was inaugurated on **24th July 2026** in the **Department of Urology**.



IV. Miscellaneous activities:

- **“Doctors Day”** was commemorated at AIIMS Nagpur on **1st July 2026**. On this solemn occasion, noted Cardiologist Dr P.K.Deshpande and well known Anesthesiologist Dr Dilip Gupta were felicitated for their exemplary contribution in their respective field of medicine.
- **A landmark achievement for AIIMS, Nagpur:** AIIMS, Nagpur is ranked 8th among India’s Best Emerging Medical Colleges and 22nd among India’s Best Medical Colleges in the India Today Best College Rankings 2026.
- **Dr Amandeep Kaur, PG-JR, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery , Department of Dentistry** won the Best Paper Award at the 28th MIDCOMS 2026 & 14th PG convention of AOMSI held at Bhopal from **2nd to 4th July 2026**.



- A deliberation meeting was organized on **10th July 2026** by the **Department of Psychiatry** in association with **Pravah Foundation and Nagpur Rural Police** with a view to strengthen community outreach and access to addiction treatment.



- **Media Capacity building workshop** was organized at AIIMS, Nagpur by UNICEF, India and PIB, Western Zone on **14th July 2026**. The event aimed to strengthen reporting on **Childhood NCDs**. A curtain raiser event witnessed an insightful session by Dr Meenakshi Girish, Professor and Head, Department of Pediatrics, AIIMS, Nagpur.



- AIIMS, Nagpur signed an **MoU with Sevadaan Aarogya Foundation (SAF)** to establish a **800 bedded Vishram Gruh** within the campus for providing affordable and safe accommodation to patients attendants.
