I. Hospital Services :--

- Total patients attended in OPD : 49,685
- IPD Admissions : 2,923
- Major surgeries performed : 922

II. Workshops, Training & Events :

- **Observance of Fire Safety Week 2026 (04th May to 10th May 2026)** : In pursuance of the directives received from the Department of Health & Family Welfare, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, the Fire Safety Week 2026 was observed at AIIMS, Nagpur from 04th May to 10th May 2026. Fire Safety Pledge was administered on the 04th of May 2026 followed by various activities viz Fire Safety Audits of various installations and units, technical webinars, practical training and quiz/poster making competition to enhance awareness and preparedness for fire prevention and emergency response to save lives.



- The **Department of Forensic Medicine & Toxicology** organized a workshop on "**Medical Certification of Cause of Death and ICD 10 Mortality Coding Training**" from 5th to 8th May 2026 in collaboration with State Bureau of Health Intelligence & Vital Statistics, Public Health Department, Government of Maharashtra & Unit for Strengthening Cause of Death, Center for Cancer Epidemiology, Tata Memorial Centre, Mumbai.
- The **Department of Neonatology** marked a landmark occasion on 10th May 2026 with the grand celebration of the 5th **Foundation Day of its Neonatal Intensive Care Unit**. The event was a powerful blend of reflection, recognition and reaffirmation – celebrating five years of life saved, families transformed and neonatal medicine advanced in one of India's most critical regions. In a deep moving gesture, **NICU graduates and their families** were felicitated and honoured with gifts.

As part of the day's activities, the Department in collaboration with **National Neonatology Forum (NNF) India**, conducted the **National NRP Day 2026** a co-ordinated single day mass training initiative under NNF **Presidential Action Plan 2026** with the theme : **One Day. One Nation, One Mission – Saving New born Lives, One Breath at a Time**". A total of 110 healthcare workers were trained in **Basic Neonatal Resuscitation**.

‘एम्स’ में अब कैंसर का सटीक इलाज

‘हेला उपकरण’ स्थापित शरीर की किसी भी गांठ पर होगा उपचार

नागपुर : मध्य भारत के कैंसर मरीजों और स्वास्थ्य क्षेत्र के लिए बेहद राहतभरी खबर है. अखिल भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान संस्थान (एम्स) ने अपने बेड़े में एक और अत्याधुनिक रेडियोथेरेपी उपकरण ‘हेला उपकरण’ स्थापित किया है. विशेष बात यह है कि मध्य भारत में यह पहली और एकमात्र ‘सरफेस गाइडेड रेडियोथेरेपी’ सुविधा है. कैंसर मरीजों की बढ़ती संख्या और समय की जरूरत को देखते हुए एम्स प्रशासन ने यह कदम उठाया है. ‘ओएनजीसी’ के सीएसआर फंड के जरिए ये अत्याधुनिक उपकरण नागपुर एम्स को मिला है. इस

आधुनिक मशीन की स्थापना केवल महिलाओं के समावेश वाली विशेष इंजीनियरिंग टीम ने की है. रेवती कृष्ण के नेतृत्व में प्राची और उनकी टीम ने यह उपलब्धि हासिल कर ‘महिला नेतृत्व वाले नवाचार और तकनीक’ की क्षमता का उत्कृष्ट उदाहरण देश के सामने रखा है. इस उपकरण के लिए एम्स के कार्यकारी

“EFFECTIVE implementation of Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA) can reduce tobacco consumption and protect public health,” said Dr (Prof) Prashant Joshi, Executive Director and CEO, AIIMS Nagpur. He was speaking during ‘World No Tobacco Day’ event at RST Cancer Hospital and Research Centre on Saturday. Dr Joshi highlighted that nearly one in ten deaths are attributable to tobacco use.

RST Cancer Hospital and Research Centre observed World No Tobacco Day on Saturday with an awareness rally and educational programme. Shrirang Ganeshe presented a regional cancer data. Dr Sachin Gathe, President of IMA Nagpur, stated that healthcare professionals have a duty to spread awareness regarding the harmful effects of tobacco and motivate people to adopt a tobacco-free lifestyle.
