A call for Project Technical Support III position announced for DHR-Funded Project titled “Effectiveness of WHO-ICOPE framework guided community-based intervention in enhancing intrinsic capacity among elderly in Nagpur: Type-I hybrid implementation Effectiveness study” under Dr. Mubashshera Firdous Khan (PI).

The total duration of the post is for 11 months initially, extended maximum up to 2.5 years depending upon the project requirement and performance.

The selected candidate is expected to work in Nagpur district.

The candidate has to bring the following documents for verification:

4. Passport size photos (Two)

Terms & conditions:

1. This post is a tenure job for fixed duration under DHR funded research project.
2. These are not the regular posts under DHR or AIIMS Nagpur.
3. Based on this experience, the selected candidate cannot claim any permanent employment either from DHR or from AIIMS Nagpur.
4. In case the candidate wishes to resign from the post, he/she should furnish a notice of 30 days' period.
5. Once the project duration is completed, the tenure is automatically completed for candidate selected for this project
6. The candidate should be able to talk fluently in English, Marathi and Hindi
7. No TA/DA will be provided for attending the interview
8. Apart from the consolidated mentioned salary per month including HRA and travel claims the candidate is not admissible for any other allowances.
9. Since this is a community-based project, the candidate has to travel across different areas of Nagpur district.

Job responsibilities:

1. Data Collection (Conducting surveys, interviews, and administering questionnaires to study participants) and maintaining detailed and precise records of field data in prescribed formats.
2. Establishing rapport with study participants, educating about the purpose of the study and obtaining informed consent and addressing concerns or doubts of participants to ensure active cooperation.
3. Conducting regular and scheduled visits to specific study sites.

4. Ensuring adherence to study timelines and completing assigned visits within deadlines.
5. Keeping accurate and timely records of all data and activities performed in the field. Reporting daily progress and challenges to supervisors or project managers.
6. Adhering to ethical guidelines and protocols approved for the research study.
7. Ensuring privacy and confidentiality of participants' data.
8. Helping with logistical arrangements such as coordinating transportation and managing supplies.
9. Identifying and resolving issues such as participant non-cooperation or logistical challenges.
10. Any other duties/responsibilities assigned by the Principal Investigator
